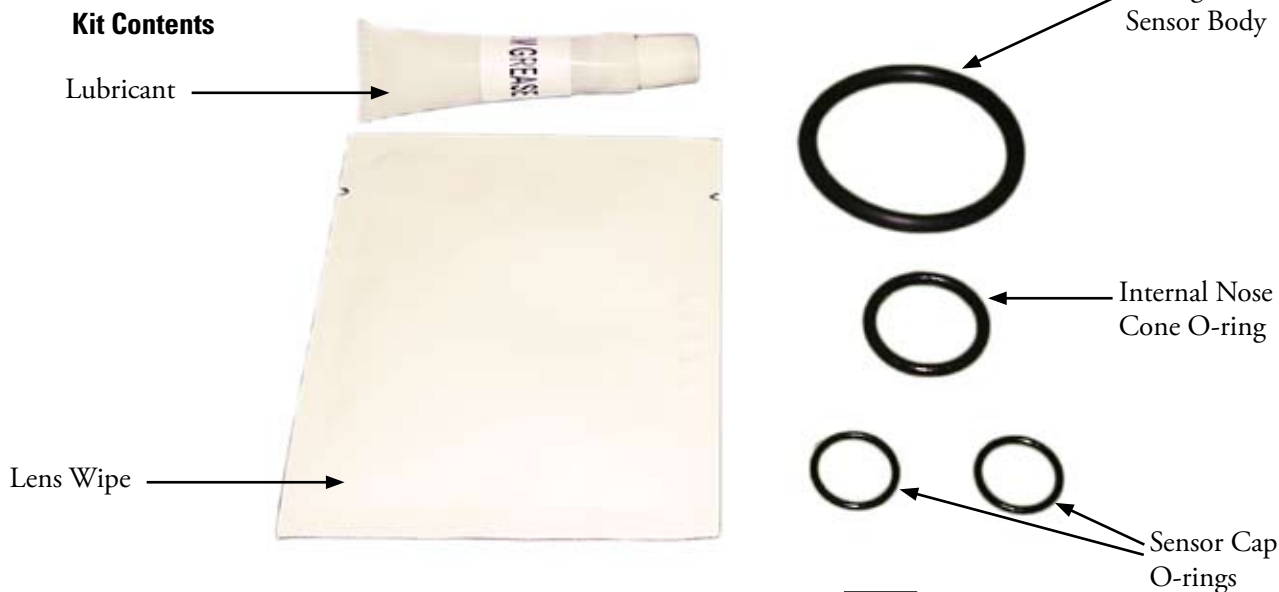


# Thermo Scientific AquaSensors™ RDO® Pro Sensor O-ring Replacement Kit, Cat. No. RDG1

## Instructions

1. Use your fingers or a non-metallic tool to remove the worn O-rings from the grooves.
2. Clean all mating surfaces with a swab or lint-free cloth.
3. Using your fingers, apply a thin layer of lubricant evenly to the new O-rings.
4. Place the new O-rings in the grooves. Remove any excess lubricant.

**Note:** Take care to avoid transferring grease from you fingers to the gold pins on the sensor or the inner lens of the sensor. Clean the lens with the included wipe after placing the two O-rings on the sensor.
